# INTRODUCING OUR NEW FAMILY OF PARISHES NAME

We would like to thank everyone who participated in our process for the naming of our Family of Parishes. It was one of the first tasks that our Transition Team was encouraged to accomplish based on the Diocesan guidelines for naming the family. The name is to identify the family as a whole - not to include the names of each parish community but needed to represent the geographical region where the family is located. Each parish and community will retain its canonical (given) name.

We are grateful for the tremendous input that we received from our parishioners at both locations. After looking over all the submissions and comments, along with prayer, discernment, and discussions from the representatives of both parishes that form our Transition Team, we decided that including Lucan in the name was more geographically reflective for St. Patrick Parish. This allowed us to easily come to a consensus and share our selection with Bishop Fabbro for his approval. We are thrilled to announce the name of our new Family of Parishes is Lucan Northwest London Catholic Family of Parishes beginning this July.





# OUTREACH MINISTRY TO THE ELDERLY IN CARE HOMES AND HOSPITALS

Since the beginning of the Pandemic (March 2020), we have been limited to how we have been able to outreach to our community – many who are confined to homes, nursing homes, hospitals, or other facilities due to the Pandemic, or for other health reasons. Much of this was due to the restrictions, protocols, and guidelines from the government, health unit, and diocese – all to mitigate the risk of Covid to residents, staff, and volunteers. We understand that this has created a void and longing for connection with our clergy, community, and faith.

As a parish, we still do not feel that it is safe, nor prudent to re-introduce our Outreach Ministry to the Elderly in Care Homes and Hospitals. We continue to work on the steps and process to ensure the safety of our community and volunteers. We know that this is a difficult time.

#### **Diocesan Pastoral Council**

Earlier this year, Bishop Fabbro announced his intention to revive the Diocesan Pastoral Council, which is a consultative body made up of the Lay Faithful that will act as an additional advisory council for the Bishop of the Diocese of London. The members of the Council will identify pastoral needs, study them, and with prayer, discernment, and dialogue, present possible solutions for the Bishop to consider.

In the coming months the diocese will host a series of Town Hall meetings for those who may be interested in being a part of this council. Following a period of discernment, two representatives from each deanery will be appointed to the council which will begin meeting in September 2022.

Please prayerfully consider attending the London region Town Hall Meeting on Tuesday, May 24 at 7:00PM at St. George's Parish Hall to get more information about the Diocesan Pastoral Council and how to submit a name for consideration to the Bishop. Please keep this initiative in your prayers as the church continues to respond the Pope Francis's call to engage synodally and give a more prominent voice to the laity in the discernment of future pastoral directions for our Diocese. # **DIOCESAN PASTORAL COUNCIL**

#### WHAT IS THE DPC?

The Diocesan Pastoral Council is a consultative body made up of the Lay Faithful, including 2 lay parishioners from each deanery, that will act as an additional advisory council for the Bishop of the Diocese of London.

#### HOW WILL IT WORK?

The Diocesan Pastoral Council will meet at least four times a year prior to the meetings of the Council of Priests. The Bishop will be present at all meetings and a short period of each meeting will be given over to prayer and reflection on the Word of God in order to discern the movement and will of the Holy Spirit.

THE PURPOSE OF THE DPC

The role of the Council is to informally investigate and weigh matters bearing on pastoral activity and to communicate to the Bishop the lived reality of the people he shepherds.

The Diocesan Pastoral Council is not a lay council as opposed to the Council of Priests, but a council that is composed of representative members of all the faithful: priests, permanent deacons, religious men and women and especially lay people...giving the laity a distinct role in this body and thus a prominent voice in the discernment of the future pastoral directions of our local Church.
