## HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND FOR FAMILIES

There are members of our Parish who are not able to attend Mass to receive the Holy Eucharist or to actively participate in our church community. Some are confined to homes, nursing homes, hospitals, or other facilities due to the Pandemic, or other health reasons.

It is our responsibility to visit these parishioners periodically and to make the Holy Eucharist available to them as often as possible.

As a temporary measure – until we can restore our ministry to the Sick and Homebound (Seniors Outreach Ministry) and until the protocols make it easier for our ministers to visit – we are asking for your assistance to bring Holy Communion to your loved ones who are sick or homebound. Family members, relatives, and close friends have a special share in this ministry of comfort. For the sick, the reception of Holy Communion is not only a privilege but also a sign of support and concern shown by the Christian community for its members who are ill.

## BUILDING FAMILY TOGETHER

Communication is such an important part of our lives and in our churches. When we do it well, everyone can understand what is going on and work together towards a common goal. For us, that means living out our Baptismal call to holiness and building a community of disciple-making disciples.

In the coming months, we will be revamping our communication platforms for both St. Patrick and Holy Family parishes. This would include the websites, Bulletins, and email communications. Our transition process to a Family of Parishes allows us to take a more intentional look at new ways in how we can connect - not only with each other, but also with the greater community.


