The Liturgy during the Easter Season brings us closer to the resurrected Jesus and makes us realize ever more how we are always united to him and he is united with us. His invitation for all of us to enter into discipleship in the context of community - His mission to send out his disciples two-by-two - is to proclaim his Kingdom as a community.

Jesus tells his chosen ones that, where two or three gather in his name he is present with them. He is making it clear that he has united himself with us, and that our life receives full meaning when we are able to give ourselves to the service of others and find meaning in that service.

Our true living comes by opening ourselves to God and to the world by becoming persons open to doing His will. The theme that dominates the readings of this Sunday are **love and service**.

OUTREACH MINISTRY TO THE ELDERLY IN CARE HOMES AND HOSPITALS

Since the beginning of the Pandemic (March 2020), we have been limited to how we have been able to outreach to our community – many who are confined to homes, nursing homes, hospitals, or other facilities due to the Pandemic, or for other health reasons. Much of this was due to the restrictions, protocols, and guidelines from the government, health unit, and diocese – all to mitigate the risk of Covid to residents, staff, and volunteers. We understand that this has created a void and longing for connection with our clergy, community, and faith.

As a parish, we still do not feel that it is safe, nor prudent to re-introduce our Outreach Ministry to the Elderly in Care Homes and Hospitals. We continue to work on the steps and process to ensure the safety of our community and volunteers. We know that this is a difficult time.

DIOCESAN PASTORAL COUNCIL



Earlier this year, Bishop Fabbro announced his intention to revive the Diocesan Pastoral Council, which is a consultative body made up of the Lay Faithful that will act as an additional advisory council for the Bishop of the Diocese of London. The members of the Council will identify pastoral needs, study them, and with prayer, discernment, and dialogue, present possible solutions for the Bishop to consider.

In the coming months the diocese will host a series of Town Hall meetings for those who may be interested in being a part of this council. Following a period of discernment, two representatives from each deanery will be appointed to the council which will begin meeting in September 2022.

Pope Francis in Canada - Walking Together July 24-29, 2022



Pope Francis will make a pastoral visit to Canada from July 24 to 29, 2022. The Pope's visit will provide a unique opportunity for him, once again, to listen and dialogue with Indigenous Peoples, to express his heartfelt closeness and to address the impact of colonization and the participation of the Catholic Church in the operation of residential schools throughout Canada. The papal visit will also provide an opportunity for the shepherd of the world's 1.2 billion Catholics to connect with the Catholic community in Canada.

The Catholic Church has a responsibility to take genuine and meaningful steps to journey with Indigenous Peoples of this land on the lengthy path to healing and reconciliation. This site will provide information on the historic journey of Pope Francis to Canada, a significant step on the road to truth, understanding and healing.
